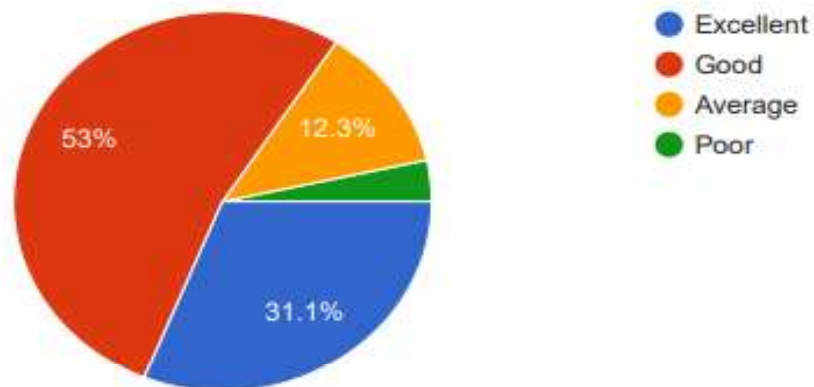

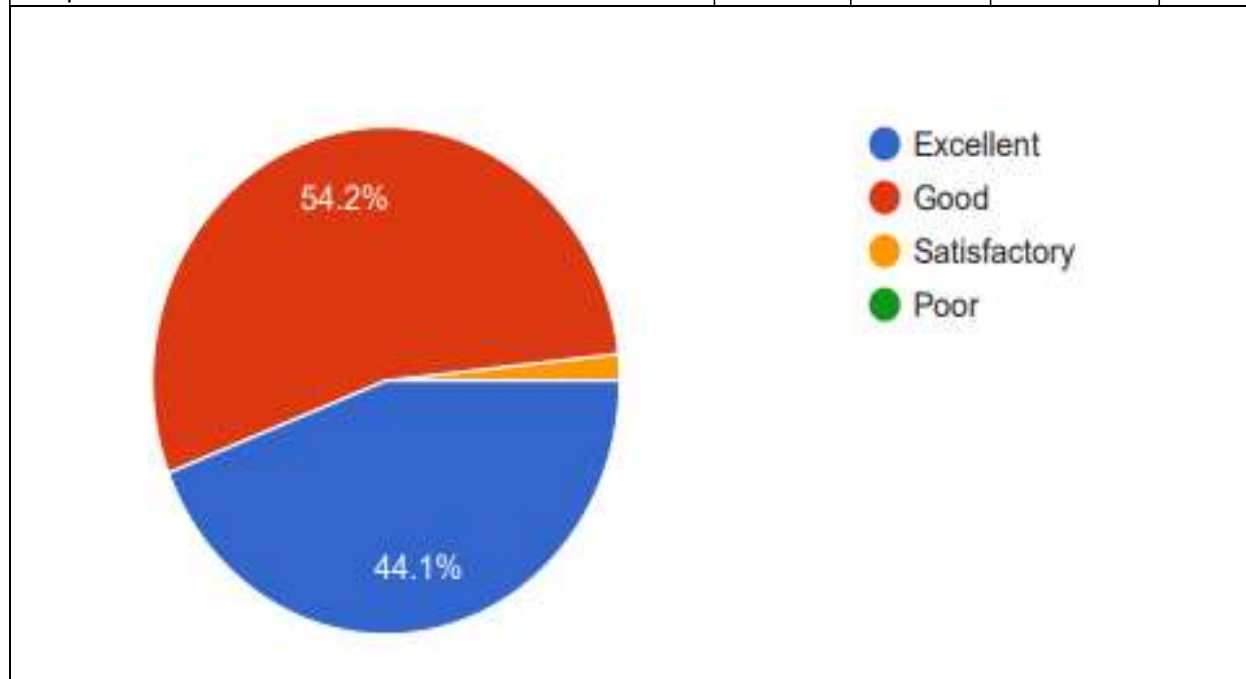
### Alumni Feedback Analysis Report 2021-2022
