An online questionnaire was made available through Google Form link to the students and they had to submit their responses to the same through the given link.

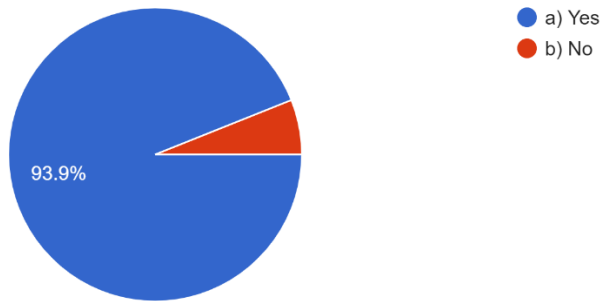
The said online questionnaire for students laid emphasis on the process of teaching, learning and evaluation in the institution.

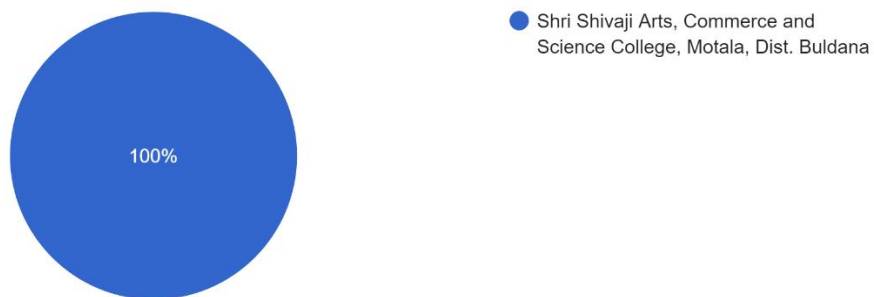

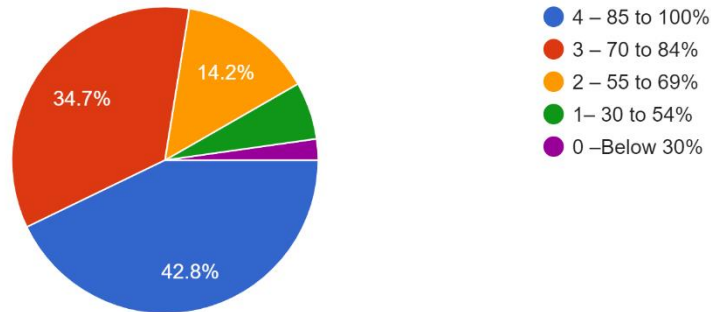

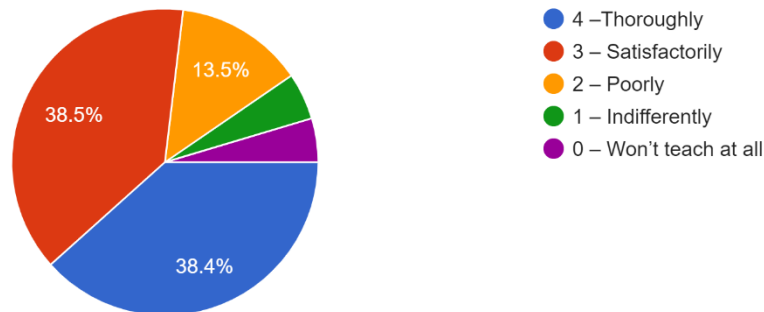
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

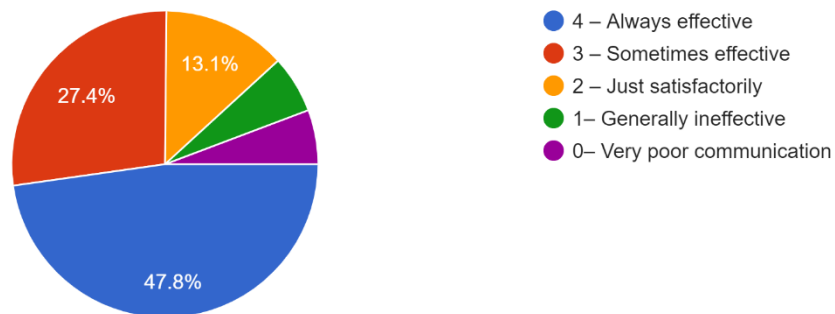

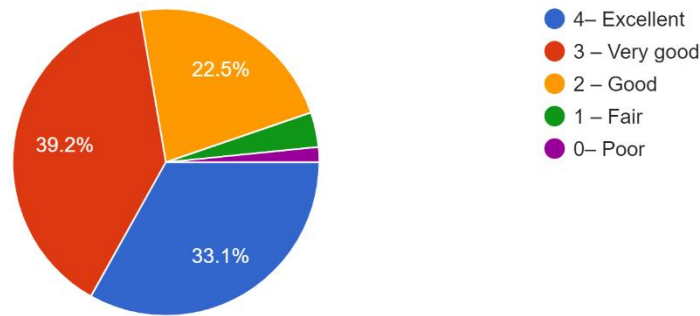

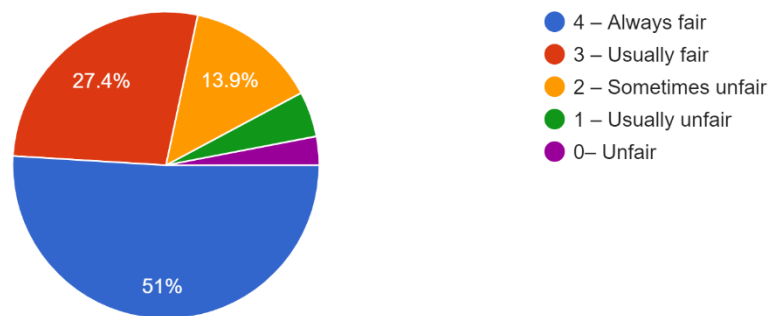

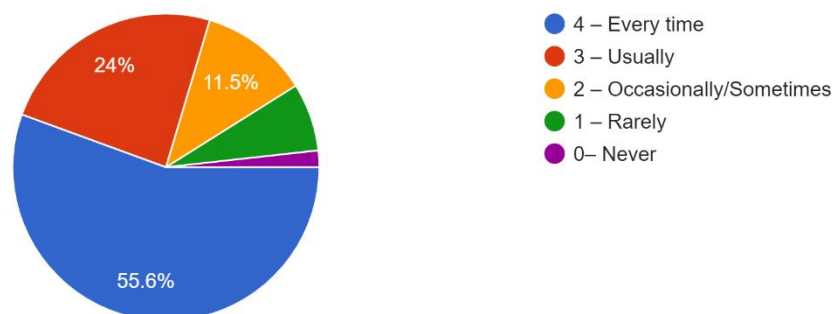

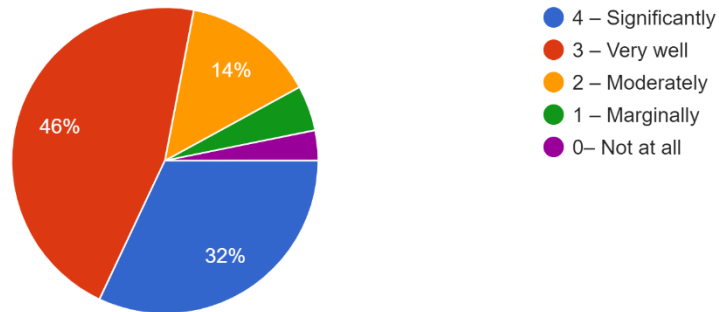

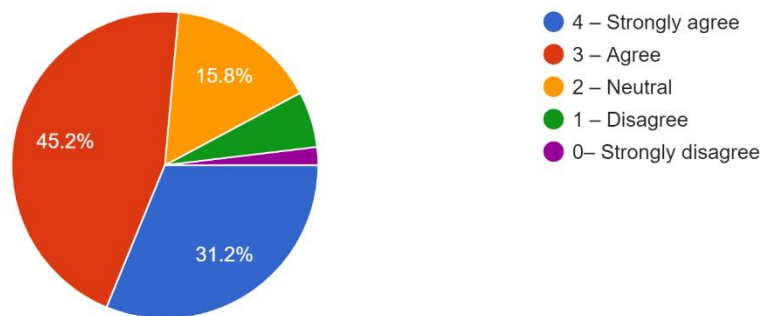

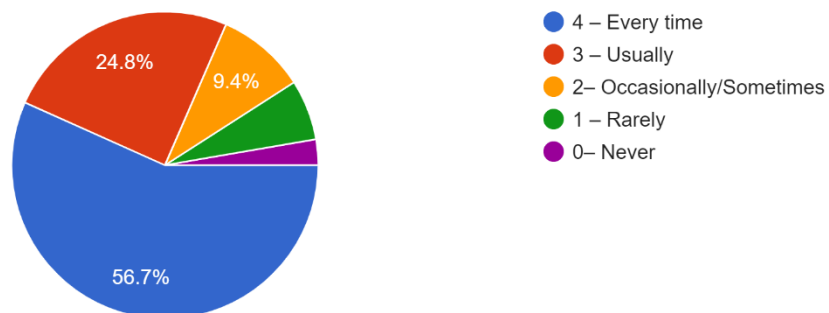

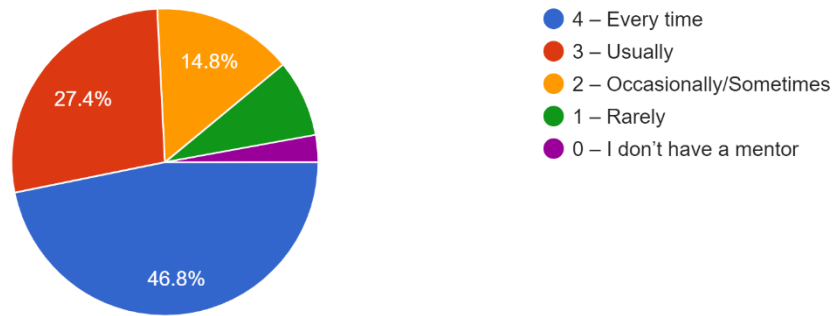

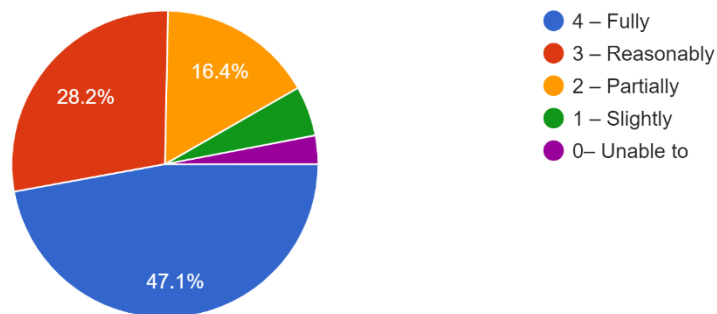

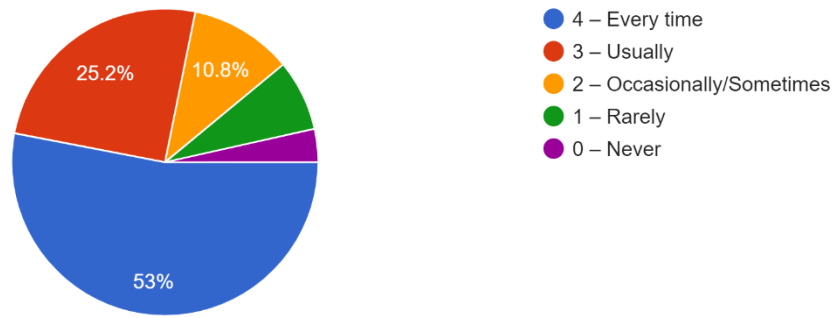

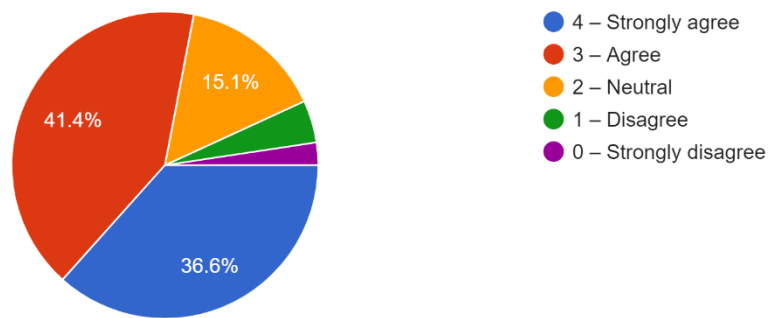

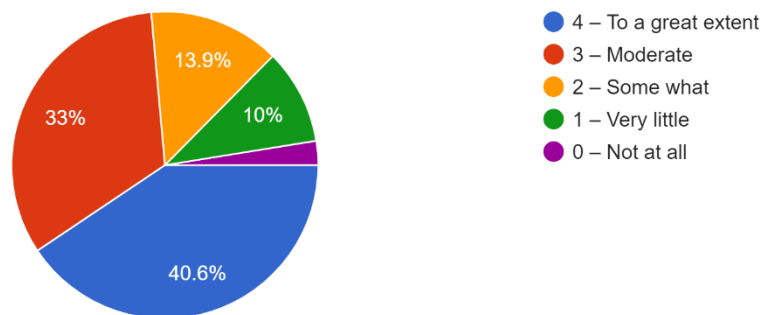
