India is home to nearly 7% of the world's biodiversity despite covering only 2.5% of the earth's land. 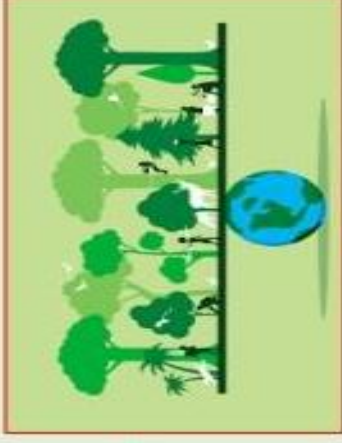

- The week comprises workshops to make people of every age comprehend the complexities of wildlife.



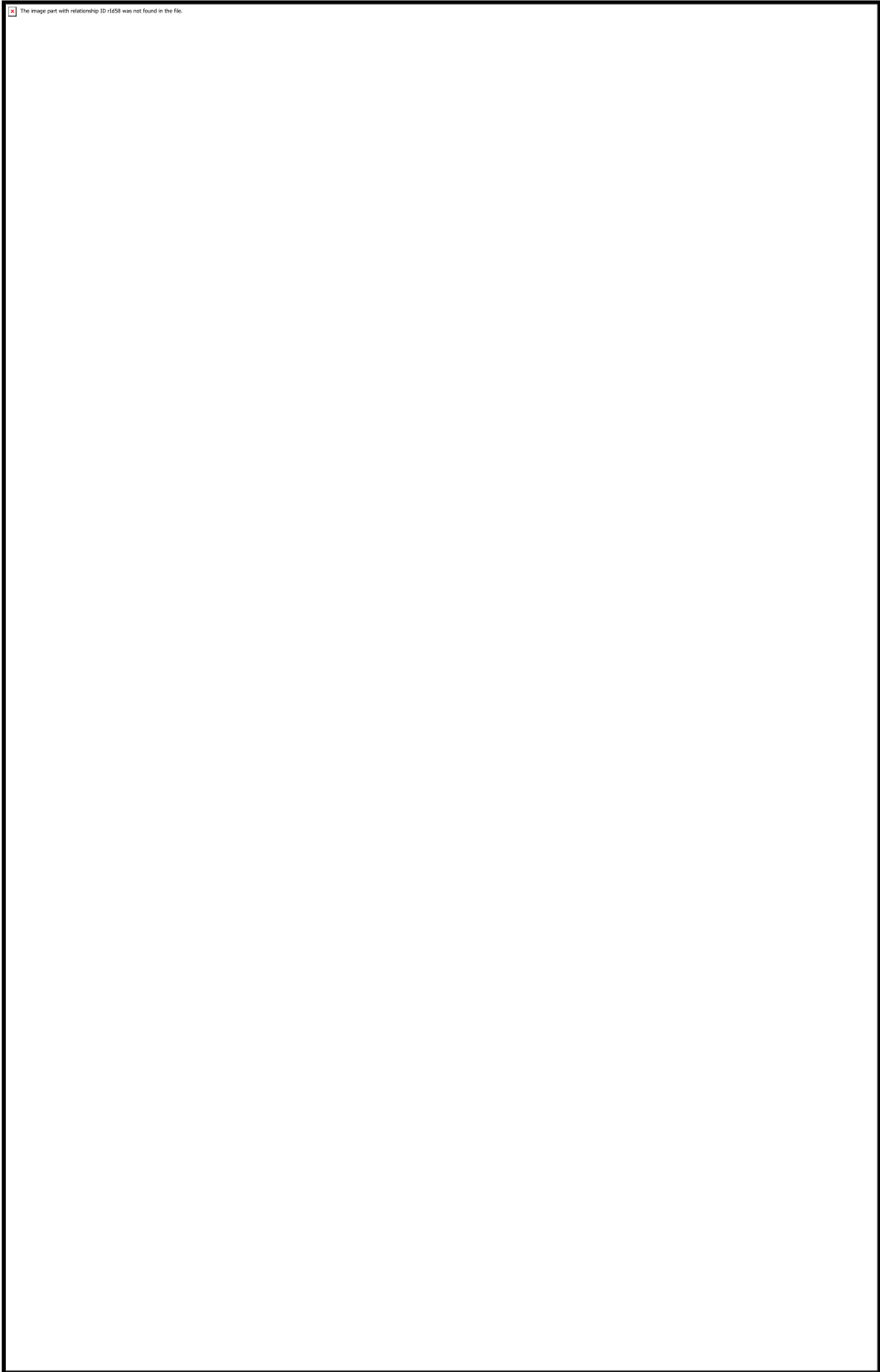
On the occasion of World Ozone Day, Dept. of Zoology and Dept. of Botany organized the online Lecture on Google meet.

The man-made chemicals that have provided most of the chlorine and bromine for ozone depletion are methyl bromide, methyl chloroform, carbon tetrachloride and families of chemicals known as halons, chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) and hydrochlorofluorocarbons (HCFCs).
