Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav:






Code of Conduct and Professional Ethics:

- ii) It fosters literacy skills in students and makes a keen interest in Marathi.

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

i) Sensitization of Students about constitutional obligations values, rights, duties, and responsibilities of citizens which makes them a responsible citizen.








- i) The students created polio awareness in the village and informed the people about its effects.

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
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

EVM and VVPAT Demonstration Program:

Department of NSS in collaboration with Tehsil office Motala Organized EVM and VVPAT demonstration program for students and staff on dated 18 January 2019. They give the demonstration of EVM in which cast the vote by pressing the blue button on the Balloting unit, a tiny lamp on the left side of the symbol glows red, and simultaneously a long beep sound is heard. Thus there are both audio and visual indications for the voter to be assured that his vote has been recorded. The control unit stores the voting count.

VVPAT is an independent system attached to the EVM that allows the voters to verify that their votes are cast as intended.

- ii) Fears and questions about voting among students were solved.

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
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

- ii) The students performed their duties diligently and cooperated in government campaigns.

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
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
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
