### **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made between the parties referred below, on this day 13 June, 2022, herein after referred as "Effective Date",

Buldhana represented herein by its Name of Competent Authority / Representative (hereinafter referred as 'First Party', the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

#### And

PAANI Foundation Motala and represented herein by its Taluka Co-Ordinator, (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party') as

#### WHEREAS:

A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:

(i) Shri Shivaji Arts Commerce & Science College, Motala.

B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.

D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

E) PAANI Foundation Motala - the Second Party is engaged in For decades, drought has ravaged thousands of villages in Maharashtra, leading to thirst, hunger, debt, forced migration and withered crops.

F) PAANI Foundation Motala - the Second Party is promoted by promoter name Group; Address and background of the Company.

G) Give related information, its branches, and dimensional information about the work with whom the MoU is sworn.

### NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS: CLAUSE 1

### **CO-OPERATION**

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

### CLAUSE 2

#### **SCOPE OF THE MoU**

2.1 Agricultural Training & Visits: Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight in to the latest developments / requirements of the Agriculture; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Agricultural Training Programs for the First Party. The Agricultural training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party

will provide its Labs / Workshops / Working Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.

2.2 Research and Development: Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of – Social work and cooperation in society.

2.3 Skill Development Programs: Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

2.4 Guest Lectures: Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.

2.5 Placement of Trained Students: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs; and will facilitate placements for the students.

2.6 There is no financial commitment on the part of the Shri Shivaji Arts Commerce & Science College Motala, the First Party to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

#### **CLAUSE 3**

#### **INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

#### **CLAUSE 4**

#### VALIDITY

4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period PAANI Foundation Motala, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of Training Partner or Name of Industry, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU

4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

#### CLAUSE 5


### **RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES**

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### About Social Forestry, Motala Division – Buldhana

The main meaning of social forestry is the program run by the people, for the people, by the people "**Social forestry** " means planting fruit trees in the vacant places, which will protect the environment as well as increase employment in rural areas. National Agriculture Commission coined the term social forestry in 1976 for a program to plant trees that supplied fuel, fodder wood and minor forest products. In this regard, as much misuse of social forestry has been done, hardly anyone else would have done it.

The National Commission on Agriculture has divided social forestry into three categories – urban forestry, rural forestry and farm forestry. Social forestry programs can be helpful in solving many problems in rural areas. Because, under this program along with the production of food grains, timber and fruits can also be produced from the same farm. Whereas climate change as the current global problem is affecting the rural life and poor sections the most, social forestry program can prove to be an important tool in reducing their ill effects.

### **Forest Management**

Amravati Territorial Circle includes Amravati, East Melghat, West Melghat and Buldhana Division. In 1964 old Buldhana Division was divided into Akola and Buldhana Division. Now, area of Buldhana Division is limited to district boundary of Buldhana District. For protection and conservation of wild life wild life divisions like Gugamal Wildlife, Melghat tiger Project, Wan Sanctuary etc. established in the Amravati District. Similarly Narnala WL in Akola District and Nyanganga WL, Ambabarwa WL in Buldhana District are established. The management of these wild life divisions is done by their respective Conservator of Forests (Wild life).

### Collaboration

**SSACSCM** and **SFM** have mutually agreed to collaborate with each other in following areas.

- 1. Extending Talent search and promotion of rural youths to undertake specialized higher studies with a focus on occupational/professional/vocational skills so as to provide work ready human resource to the local/ regional industries.
- 2. Extending placement assistance as prospective/potential employers.
- 3. Conducting in house-training, on job training, workshop, seminars and technical sessions by inviting experts from the relevant fields.
- 4. To motivate faculty members and students to join Green Army
- 5. Mutual implementation of Nature clubs activities within college and outside the college.
- 6. Plantation and conservation of ornamental, fruit plant, timber yielding, fiber yielding plants, medicinal plant other economical important rare plants in college campus.
- Students will understand and gain knowledge about various programs and project conduct under Social Forestry department of Maharashtra. For Example 'Kanya Jansamrudhi Yojana' etc.
- 8. Through mutual cooperation and support towards establishing center of skill based certificate courses. For example Certificate Course in Plant Propagation and Nursery Management.

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- 9. To protect the forest producer from exploitation of the middlemen and safeguard the interest of the consumers by undertaking proper and scientific exploitation of the forest resources of the District and if necessary outside it.
- 10. To transfer related technology to farmers.
- 11. Development of herbal parks, raising medicinal plants and processing the same.
- 12. Establishment of camping sites for nature education to students.
- 13. Any other activities to strengthen the following ambience for the students.

### **Terms and Condition of MoU**

Confidentiality: Any modification in this MoU shall be made only after prior and written mutual consent between both the parties.

Validity: This MoU will be applicable for a period of Five year from the date of its execution, and may be renewed by both parties on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed.

Review: The MOU shall be reviewed at the end of one year from the date of signing of this MOU. Either party can terminate the MOU after giving one month's notice to the other party subject to fulfillment of commitment already agreed upon.




