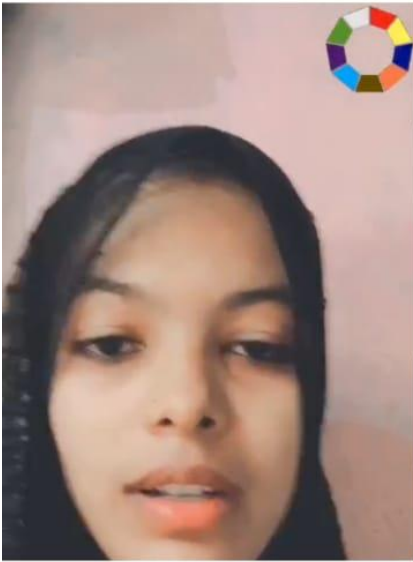

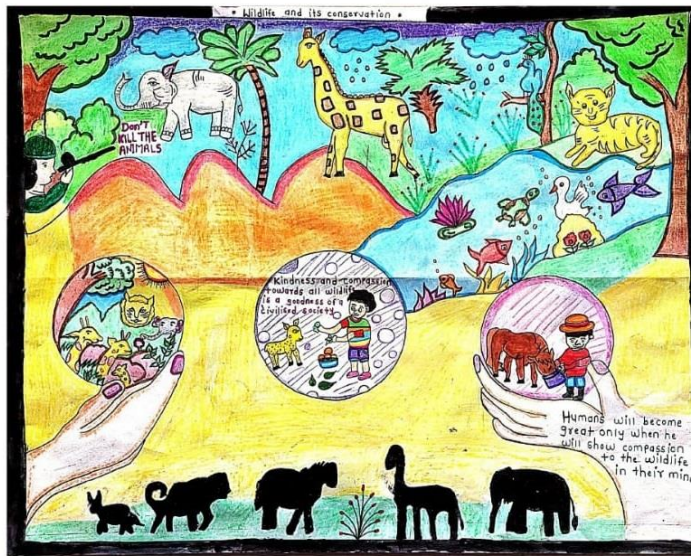

Effect of Climate change on wildlife

wildfire
wildfire alter the source of food, water, shelter for wildlife causes a migration and even death of the animals

Risk of Extinction
The IUCN has assessed roughly 3% of described species and identified 16,928 species worldwide as being threatened with extinction or roughly 38% of those assessed .

Forest becomes Desert
as land is overused and scorched by the hot sun and no rain, it dries up and vegetation cover diminishes due to both drought and wildfire. lack of vegetation leads to further loss of humidity and increase erosion rates, so desert expand even more.

climate change = loss of Biodiversity

one million animals and plants species threatened with extinction. e.g Reptiles, water birds, Amphibian, mammals

The population of the world's wildlife has fallen by 68% since 1970 due to climate change shifts in food availability and failure of ecological relationship with other species - e.g the loss of critical pollinators or mutualistic fixers.

Expansion, contraction and migration of habitat, increased incidence of disease and invasive species, change in temp. precipitation and other environmental condition.

A decrease in snow cover (already declined by 10% since 1960s), the added water from melting ice sheets and glaciers and the expansion of seawater as it warms.



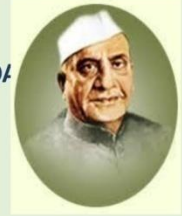

Lunar Lake, Bahadur District, Maharashtra

Pink hue (Pheo-L) in Lunar Lake due to sulfurizing bacteria

Cluster of cells of Halobacterium

Normalized difference halobacterium index (NDHI)

- The colour of Lunar lake water in Maharashtra's Bahadur district turned pink due to a large presence of the salt-loving 'Halobacterium' microbes, a probe carried out by a Pune-based Agarkar Research Institute along with National Environmental Engineering Research Institute (NEERI), Nagpur have concluded. Halobacterium is a bacteria culture that creates pink pigment and exists in saline water. It formed a pink coloured mat on the lake surface.
- On further investigation, it was also discovered that the pink colour of the water was not permanent. Once the biomass of the microbes settled at the bottom, the water became transparent during the next experiment at the lake. One of the scientists told a news website that the water of the lake is returning to its normal colour due to the dilution by monsoon rain. Agarkar Research Institute Director Dr. Prashant Dhakephalkar reportedly told the website that they have also discovered that the pink plumage of the fountains visiting the lake is due to the carbonic-rich hood they had eaten at the lake.

MATERIAL: - Water, Carbon Dioxide, Oxygen, Nitrogen, Methane, etc.

DEFINITIONS: - The increase in the temperature of the oceans, atmosphere, caused by the rise of certain gases.

SCIENTIST SVANTE ARRHENIUS: - Swedish Professor who predicted this change in atmospheric carbon dioxide levels could subsequently affect the surface temperature through greenhouse effect.

EFFECTS: - Rising sea levels due to thermal expansion of the oceans and ice sheets melting from the poles.

CONCLUSION: - Reducing the amount of the greenhouse gases is the only way to prevent global warming and other associated effects.

Green Chemistry

1) **Prevention:** - Waste prevention is better than waste treatment or cleanup.

2) **Atom Economy:** - Synthetic methods should be designed to maximize the incorporation of all materials used in the process into the final product.

3) **Less Hazardous Chemical Synthesis:** - Synthetic methods should be designed that prevent the use of or the formation of toxic substances and the environment must be safe.

4) **Designing Safer Products:** - Chemical products should be designed to effect their desired function while minimizing their toxicity.

5) **Safer Solvents and Auxiliaries:** - The use of auxiliary substances (e.g. solvents, separation agents) should be made unnecessary wherever possible.

6) **Design for Energy Efficiency:** - Energy requirements of chemical processes should be minimized. If possible, synthetic methods should be conducted at ambient temperature and pressure.

7) **Use of Renewable Feedstocks:** - A raw material or feedstock should be renewable rather than depleting whenever technically and economically practicable.

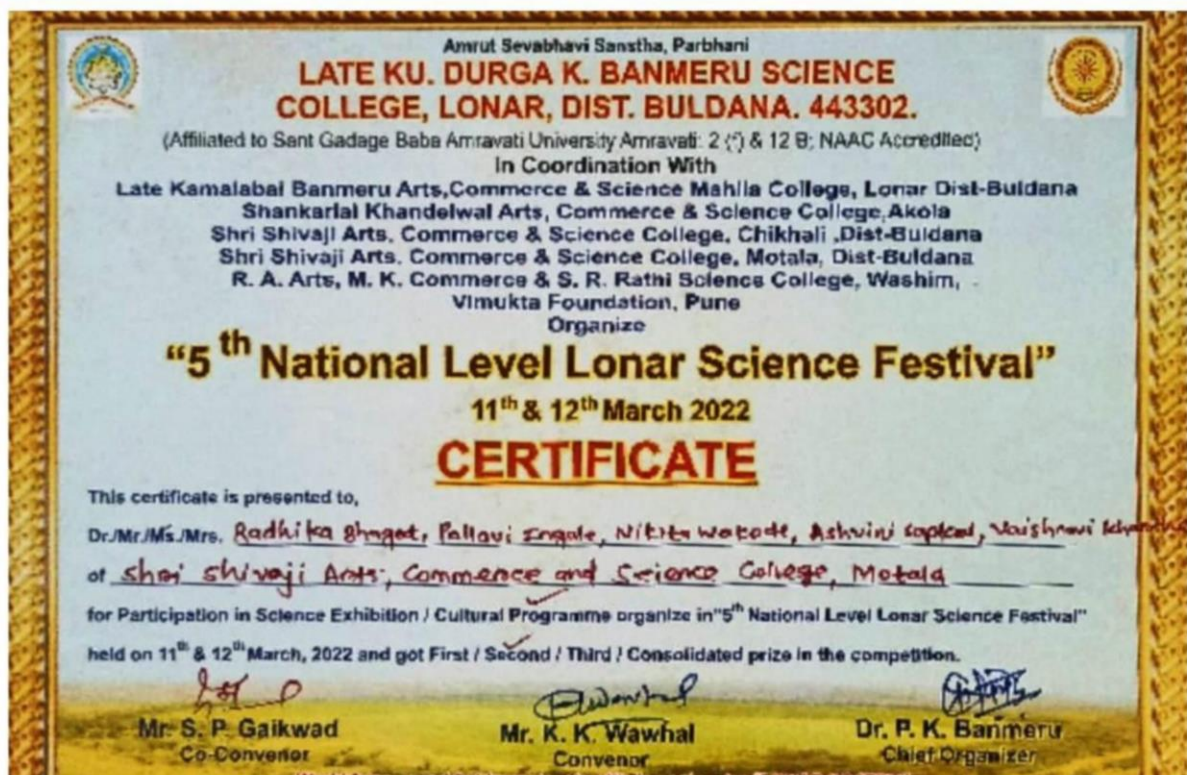
8) **Reduce Derivatives:** - Unnecessary derivatization (e.g. protecting groups, protection/deprotection, temporary modification of physical/chemical properties) should be avoided whenever possible.

9) **Maximize Atom Economy:** - Catalysts (preferably selective and reusable) are superior to stoichiometric reagents.

10) **Design for Degradation:** - Chemical products should be designed so that at the end of their function they break down into innocuous degradation products and do not persist in the environment.

11) **Real-time analysis for Pollution Prevention:** - Analytical methods developed to be further developed to allow for real-time, in-process monitoring and control prior to the formation of hazardous substances.

12) **Inherently Safer Chemistry for Accident Prevention:** - Substances and the form of a substance used in a chemical process should be chosen to minimize the potential for chemical accidents, including releases, explosions, and fires.
